**WHERE:** Anoka Nature Preserve,  
4301 Parkview Lane, Anoka MN 55303  
Located along the beautiful Rum River to the  
northwest of Bunker Lake Blvd and 7th Ave NW,  
in the city of Anoka.

**WHEN:** Saturday September 9, 2017. MN Youth  
Waterfowl Day. Hunt will take place from 1/2  
hour before sunrise to approximately 12pm.

**WHO:** Youth age 15 and under accompanied by  
non-hunting adult. Volunteers will provide  
everything needed to provide the memories of a  
quality hunt. Must provide your own shotgun.

#### HOW MORNING HUNTS UNFOLD:

- Hunters will meet volunteers on the morning  
of the hunt in the Anoka Nature Preserve  
parking lot. Waivers of Claim will be signed  
at this time.
- Hunters will then be transported to the field  
where blinds and decoys will be set up for the  
hunt.
- Volunteers will be calling birds and providing  
dogs for retrieving, as well as patrolling the  
perimeter of the field ensuring a safe hunt.
- 20ga & 12ga ammunition will be provided for  
the hunt—thanks to our good friends at  
Federal Premium Ammunition in Anoka.
- Lunch and photo opportunity will be provided  
at the end the day.
